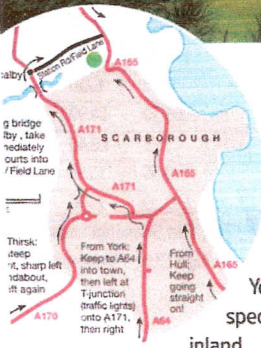

Our Club Site at Scarborough lies just north of the Victorian seaside town after which it is named and is an ideal base for exploring the cliffs and beaches of Yorkshire's coast, as well as the spectacular North York Moors inland.

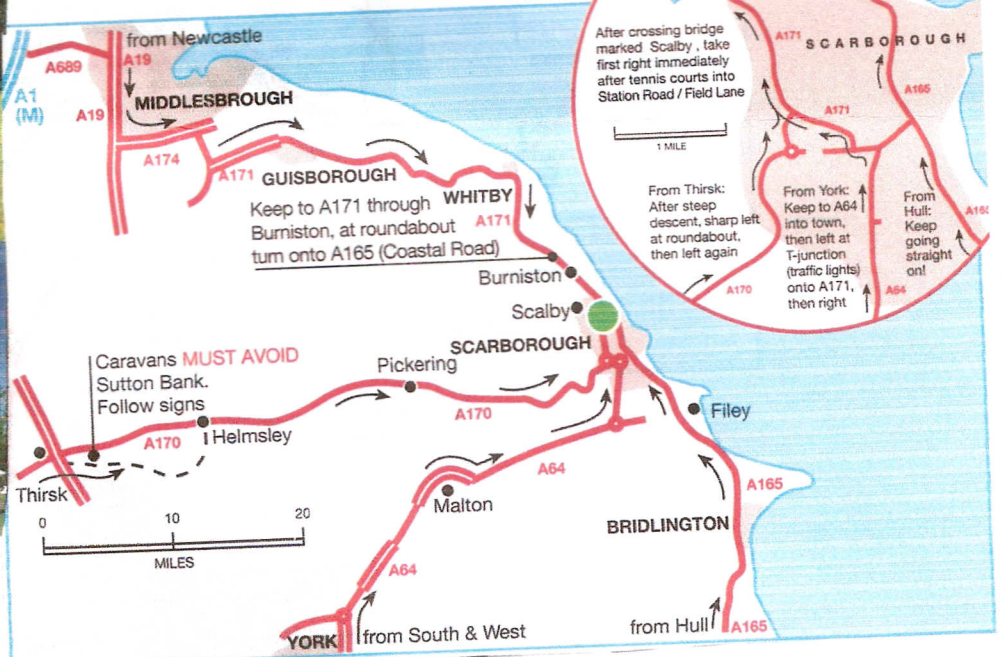
The beach is only a 15-minute cliff-top walk from the site, while the town of Scarborough, which has two sandy bays divided by the castle headland, is three miles away. The town offers a variety of attractions, including Scarborough Sea and Marine Sanctuary, Scarborough Castle, the Rotunda Museum and miniature railway the North Bay Railway. There is a host of walking options in the area. The Cleveland Way National Trail is just ten minutes' walk from the site, the North Yorkshire Moors National Park is perfect for hikers and cyclists, and Robin Hood's Bay is the eastern end of the Coast-To-Coast walk.

Railway station: Scarborough 3 miles.

Bus stop: From site entrance on routes to Scarborough and Ravenscar (limited service). Circular service incorporating Sealife Centre and town centre.

Worth noting: Well-stocked shop with camping accessories on site and café serving breakfast and fish and chips (take-away available). Barbecue shelter is available. Some pitches are sloping and chocks may be required. To book a Jumbo Pitch contact site direct.

Eat Local: Hares Leap Farm shop sells game, free-range poultry and eggs, organic meat, locally-grown vegetables and herbs and home-made pickles, chutneys, pates, pies and more.
